Hurricane Preparedness

Hurricane season begins on June 1st and lasts through November 30th. In the event of a declared emergency remember to contact your licensing authority to update them on the status of your operation within 24 hours. Also, coordinate with your licensing counselor to ensure that all contact information is up to date as they will be looking to contact you as well.

ISSUES TO CONSIDER DURING A RECOVERY PERIOD:

- If the child care home sustains structural damage, regardless of the extent, an on-site inspection is required PRIOR to caring for children.
- An alternate power source, such as a generator, must be permanently installed and maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations and comply with the Florida Building Code and the Florida Fire Prevention Code 69A-60, F.A.C.
- The alternate power source and fuel supply shall be located in an area that is not subject
 to flooding or damage from storm surge. The alternate power source must be approved
 by local and state authorities and be in place prior to usage.
- If flooding has occurred within the home, clean up must occur before allowing children
 in care, including the disposal or sanitization of any toys and equipment impacted by the
 water.
- Be aware of Boil Water Notices in your area.
- Outdoor areas must be safe for play and free from debris.
- Children may be accepted on a temporary basis; however, the licensed capacity may never be exceeded.

Remember that, regarding damage, each and every situation must be assessed on an individual basis and determinations are made based on protecting the health, safety and well-being of the children in care.
