
Annette has earned her AS Degree in Early Childhood Education. She would like to thank the most High God for helping her and her business prosper.

Trauma-Informed Care for Child Care Program Directors (TICD)



The Department of Children and Families Office of Child Care Regulation is offering a new instructor-led course, *Trauma-Informed Care for Child Care Program Directors*. The goal of the course is to assist child care programs in implementing trauma-informed care for the families they serve. This is a multi-session course, which will require the completion of outside assignments and readings. Upon completion of this course, child care program directors will form a community of practice and will be able to:

- Recognize the signs of trauma impacting children
- Examine the importance of self-care
- Apply tools to help children regulate emotions and behaviors
- Evaluate the physical learning environment for trauma-sensitive supports
- o Develop a plan for creating a trauma-sensitive program

This course can be used to meet the Florida Director Credential Renewal requirements. To access this course, go to



SUBMIT a 300 word essay describing specific examples on **how and why** the person or organization you nominate is **outstanding**, **fits the description**, and is **well-deserving** of the annual award.

AHAP - AGENCIES HELP ASSOCIATIONS PROSPER

The AHAP award is **given to an organization** such as an Agency, Coalition, Food Program, College, etc. that has **given support and helped your local chapter association** above and beyond their regular services.

OUTSTANDING FFCCHA CHAPTER

The Outstanding Chapter award is **given to one local FFCCHA chapter** that is doing extraordinary things. It could be a parent involvement event, an outstanding membership drive, or maybe your association made a big difference by being involved with your local coalition or another type of special activity.

The chapter event must have taken place between April 1, 2019 and March 31, 2020.

They will need to submit a chapter display board spotlighting the event at the conference and will receive one comp hotel night at the Sheraton Sand Key Resort in Clearwater Beach.

FFCCHA - FAMILY CHILD CARE HALL OF FAME

The Hall of Fame awards are the most prestigious awards given by FFCCHA, Inc. This award is given to a FCC Provider and an Advocate (non-provider) in the state of Florida that exemplifies Family Child Care. Each has separate qualifications. The winners must submit an 8 x 10 photo for the conference Hall of Fame display board.

PROVIDER HALL OF FAME

Erickson Institute Family Child Care Study



Family child care is an essential component of the child care supply, meeting the needs of families who want the individual attention that providers offer to small groups of children, the flexibility that fit their work hours, and the convenience of care in the neighborhood. Yet the number of family child care providers across the U.S. has declined dramatically in the past decade, limiting options for families.

In early 2019, the Foundation for Child Development awarded a grant to Erikson Institute, a nationally recognized research center, to conduct an exploratory study to examine the factors that contribute to this decline. The study includes focus group discussions with FCC providers to learn about the reasons they engage in family child care initially as well as the reasons they continue in the field. The discussions provide an opportunity to have a voice in informing policy and program recommendations that affect family child care.

Erikson has selected four states as study sites; Florida is one of them. We will be conducting two focus group discussions at the Florida Family Child Care Association Leadership Summit on February 29, 2020. The discussions, which will be audio-recorded, will be 2-hours long, and will include a short, written survey about experiences providing family child care. Participation is voluntary and confidential. Your name and any information about you will not be shared with anyone outside the research team and no information that could identify you will be used in any reports. Participants will receive a \$20 gift card. They will also have an opportunity to receive research reports from the project.

We are particularly interested in talking to family child care providers who are newly licensed within the last year as well as those who provide VPK, Early Head Start, School Readiness and those who are nationally accredited family child care providers.
