

Legislative News

Lynn Gibson, Legislative Liaison

It feels so good to be back working with FFCCHA members this year. I am ready to get back into working with legislators and those that are in positions to help Florida's family child care providers stay in business and pro-



tect the children in their care. I would love to have help and am asking that each chapter please try to get one person that is willing to be the contact to work with me. Please have them contact me, my email address and phone number are in the Grapevine on page 10.

I have already jumped in with both feet! I applied for and was accepted to sit on the "Re-envisioning Child Care Roundtable" with Child Care Aware of America.

The event was held on September 26th via Zoom. 50 people were on the call, with about 10 of them being Child Care Aware staff or speakers for the event. We were able to hear about the problems that are popping up around the United States and how different communities are handling them. It was heartbreaking to hear how many have or will have to shut down their centers or homes due to the pandemic.

We listened to 5 center or home providers tell their story then we were sent into breakout rooms to speak to each other. Dr. Kim Engelman was in charge of our breakout room and provided the questions that Child Care Aware wanted answers for. Below are the questions we were asked.

- #1. What was the status of your child care facility prior to the pandemic? How were you doing financially, staff wise with children?
- #2. What are the biggest challenges you are facing as a provider right now, months after the beginning of the pandemic?
- #3. What programs or system are not working to best support child care providers?
- #4. As a provider are there any regulations that you struggle with right now that are burdensome to meet? If so, what categories do those regulations fall into?

Paperwork / Background Checks / CCDF / Health and Safety Regulations / QRIS / Zoning/Fire Safety

- #5. Do you have a sense of how many child care programs are likely to permanently close or have closed in your community/state as a result of these challenges?
- #6. Are there any temporary changes implemented during the pandemic that have been critical support for families/low income families that should be extended permanently?
- #7. What programs or systems are not working to best support families especially low-income families?

That is all I have for now! I will keep you all updated as I get back to working on some legislative ideas. Stay safe out there, and I cannot wait to see you all again.
