

TRAUMA-INFORMED CARE for CHILD CARE PROFESSIONALS (TICC)

The Department of Children and Families, Office of Child Care Regulation is offering a new 5-hour course, which provides child care professionals with an overview of the impact of trauma on children and families and how to incorporate learning strategies to decrease stress in the classroom.

After training, you will be able to:

- Identify age-related signs of stress and trauma in children
- Describe the role caregivers play in promoting connections and buffering the effects of adversity
- Identify how stress and trauma can negatively impact the cognitive, emotional, behavioral, and physical development of young children
- Identify resources and strategies to use to provide trauma-informed care

FREE Trauma-Informed Care for Child Care Professionals (TICC) course

In recognition of National Child Abuse Prevention Month, DCF invites School Readiness personnel to take our Trauma-Informed Care for Child Care Professionals (TICC) course for free during the month of April.

In addition to helping identify the signs of stress and learning techniques to create a trauma-sensitive environment in the classroom, this five-hour online course contributes to in-service training requirements. To take advantage of this free offer, log into your Child Care Training student account, register and complete TICC from April 1 – 30.

NOTE: In order to take advantage of the free opportunity, you must complete the course before midnight (EST) on April 30, 2022. If you do not complete the course before this deadline, you will be automatically removed from the course and you will have to register again to take the course for the full cost of \$10.

Opening a Family Child Care Home Program (OPENH)

The Department of Children and Families Office of Child Care Regulation is offering a new online course, Opening a Family Child Care Home Program. The goal of this course is to provide individuals with an overview of opening a family child care home program in Florida.

Upon completion of this course, child care professionals will be able to:

- Describe the responsibilities of a family child care provider
- Analyze the need for a family child care home in your area and what services are needed
- Establish goals and a guiding philosophy for your family child care home
- Identify the operational requirements of opening a family child care home
- Develop finance and budget management plans for the program
- Identify elements of program structure that need to be developed that may cause delays in the development of literacy

For this three-hour course, 0.3 CEUs may be earned (if this course is taken in the Training and Registry Portal). To access the course, go to: https://www.myflfamilies.com/service-programs/child-care/ and select "Training Credentialing."

Differential Monitoring in Family Day Care Homes and Large Family Child Care Homes

In partnership with the National Association for Regulatory Administration (NARA), the Office Licensing has started the process of implementing a key indicator system which will allow for abbreviated inspections in Family Day Care Homes (FDCH) and Large Family Child Care Homes (LFCCH). Providers benefit from shorter inspections by maintaining compliance and children in care enjoy a higher degree of health and safety protection.

For a FDCH or LFCCH to qualify for an abbreviated inspection, the provider must be licensed for a period of no less than two consecutive years, the provider must not have any Class I or Class II deficiencies, as defined by rule, for at least two consecutive years, and the provider is not currently under investigation by Child Protective Services. An abbreviated inspection shall only be conducted in lieu of a routine inspection [if above criteria is met], never a renewal inspection.
