What can you do to help pass good laws for Family Child Care in Florida? With 2023 being an odd year, Florida will begin their session on March 7, 2023. Even years begin earlier in the month of January, so we need to get started on necessary bills that pertain to Child Care now.

FFCCHA is gathering support for changes to a current statute that already exists but needs to have language added to it. This update would help protect Large Family Child Care Homes across the state of Florida from being shut down due to their home owner insurance being cancelled.

Please help us work on this needed legislation now, and ask your local chapter to get involved.

#### **DCF Child Care Updates**

#### Top 5 Tips for Provider Payments

To help ensure successful provider payments, please follow the below tips:

- 1. Send completed forms. Without the Renewal Licensure Fee Invoice or Administrative Fine Invoice forms, payment cannot be processed correctly and most likely will be returned.
- 2. Put the license number on the check or money order.
- 3. Make sure the payment is for the correct amount.
- 4. Do not send applications with payment. They will be returned.
- 5. Do not send mail via FedEx or UPS, as they will not deliver to the PO Box.

#### **New Transcript**

The Child Care Training Transcript was updated in July. In addition to a new design, the transcript now features the below enhancements:

- Field for Training Start Date
- Page numbers
- Additional Section for Training as Needed or Applicable
- Watermark, boarder, and landscape orientation design

If you need help with navigating the new transcript, a guide has been developed to provide a sample of the new transcript. This guide can also be found on the DCF website on the Training and Credentialing page under "Credentials."



#### What is a Key Indicator Inspection?

A Key Indicator inspection is a type of abbreviated inspection where a set of rules are measured. These rules have been statistically proven to demonstrate full compliance with all child care rules. Rules that pose the greatest risk of harm to children, if violated, are also measured. In addition, five additional randomly selected rules will be measured.

#### **Differential Monitoring Check-in**

Effective July 8, 2022, the new abbreviated inspection process was implemented for eligible child care facilities, followed shortly by the implementation of the new process for eligible family day care homes/large child care homes on July 28, 2022.

To date, 843 abbreviated inspections have been completed for facilities and 63 abbreviated inspections for homes.

#### Opening a Family Child Care Home Program (OPENH)

The Department of Children and Families Office of Child Care Regulation is offering a new online course, Opening a Family Child Care Home Program. The goal of this course is to provide individuals with an overview of opening a family child care home program in Florida.

Upon completion of this course, child care professionals will be able to:

- Describe the responsibilities of a family child care provider
- Analyze the need for a family child care home in your area and what services are needed
- Establish goals and a guiding philosophy for your family child care home
- Identify the operational requirements of opening a family child care home
- Develop finance and budget management plans for the program
- Identify elements of program structure that need to be developed that may cause delays in the development of literacy

For this three-hour course, 0.3 CEUs may be earned (if this course is taken in the Training and Registry Portal). #### 2022 Early Educators Leadership / CDA Conference

The 2022 Early Educators Leadership Conference "Leading Career Pathways to Equity" from the Council for Professional Recognition (CDA) was an occasion for decision makers and participants in early childhood to gain knowledge, learn new skills, and network with colleagues to expand the field of early childhood education.

The core of the CDA conviction has remained that all young children have a basic right to equity in education.

- The CDA is the only national, muti-language credential that assesses educators in the language of their daily work.
