## Florida FCCH Facts

**2,417 total Family Child Care Homes**: registered (501) licensed (1,465) large licensed (410) and military (41). FCC homes offer the Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten-VPK (40), Early Head Start–EHS (70), School Readiness–SR (1,179) and participate on the USDA Child Care Food Program (1,364). Children served: VPK(240), EHS(554) SR(8,851). Average CLASS Composite Scores: VPK 5.48, SR 5.43. Overall, **24,300** of our youngest, most impressionable **children** are being cared for and educated in regulated family child care homes! There are **153 Gold Seal** and **NAFCC (nationally) Accredited** family child care homes – **1**<sup>st</sup> in the nation!
